

**COVID-19:** We will be implementing the following precautions to ensure the safety of our patients and staff:

Please contact our office/ inform our staff to reschedule an upcoming appointment should **YOU** or a **FAMILY MEMBER** experience **ANY** of the following:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Muscle pain/ body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Nausea/vomiting
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea

--We will post a notice on the front door that if you have any of the above symptoms, to return to your car and call the office to reschedule.

--**We ask that patients attend their appointment ALONE or by ONLY ONE family member if patient is young. Please refrain from bringing siblings and friends to the appointment as they will be asked to not enter the treatment areas.**

--Upon sign in, all patients and accompanying adults will need to sanitize hands at the front desk, we will have a sanitization station set up. We will also check your temperature. Any temperature greater than 100.0F will be rescheduled.

--Any patient with a cough will be removed from the public areas.

--You have the option to wait in your vehicle while waiting to be called back for your dental visit. We will call you when your chair is ready.

--We will be taking extra precautions by cleaning and sanitizing main areas throughout the office on an hourly basis. We will remove magazines, toys, and books.

Office COVID precautions:

- State of the art sterilization
- Air purifiers in each individual operatory, as well as waiting areas

- Clinical staff are in full PPE with respirator masks and face shields
- Disinfection of main areas every hour
- Temperature checks daily for staff as well as patients once they enter the building.
- Prescreening questions for all patients prior to appointments as well as staff prior to starting their work day.
